Visakha records the best performance indices

It is a great pleasure to state that Visakha Vidyalaya has achieved the highest performance indices, based on ordinary level and advanced level examination results in the year 2011.

The performance indicator (Composite school performance index), issued by the Department of Examinations, was developed based on the ability displayed by the students at public examinations and considered a reliable index of performance than measures such as number of students getting 3 'A's. Schools all over the Island are then given a rank based on the score of the index.

In 2011 our school achieved the highest composite school performance index within the advanced level science stream. It is also a pleasure to state that the index shows an increment of 5 points (66 in year 2010, 71 in year 2011) compared to the previous year.

For the advanced level non science subjects, the composite school performance index was 69, which ranks our school in 4th place. This also shows an increment of 1 point compared with the previous year. According to the 2011 ordinary level examination results we have achieved a Composite school performance index of 80. This is the highest index achieved out of all the schools which conduct classes from grade one. We also have the record of highest number of students with 9 A's in both year 2010 and 2011.

I would like to thank all who have contributed and helped the students of Visakha Vidyalaya to achieve such success and hope that we continue to reach the high standards we have done to date.

- Members who have served on the Executive Committee for a period of 2 years or more & are of high integrity & efficient are eligible for nomination as Office Bearers. However the maximum number of occasions as Office Bearer is 06.

Non-eligibility

• No member whose daughter's application is to be submitted for admission to any grade of Visakha Vidyalaya for any particular year, shall be eligible for election to the Executive Committee for the one (01) year immediately preceding the year of submission of such application for admission and until the admission process is complete

Eg: No member whose daughter's application is to be submitted in 2013 shall be eligible for election to the Executive Committee 2012/2013 and until the admission process is complete

- No member of the Association shall be elected a member of the Executive Committee for more than three (03) consecutive years. (this does not apply to Office Bearers)
- No member who has been elected as an Executive Committee Member or an Office Bearer in a Past Pupils' Association of
 another school; shall be eligible for election to the Executive Committee of the Visakha Vidyalaya Old Girls' Association
 for that particular year
- No member may be elected an Office Bearer of the Association on more than six (06) occasions
- An Office Bearer on being elected to such office each year could hold a particular office for a maximum period of two years. However in the absence of nominations for a particular office in any given year, such a member who has held such office for more than two years may be appointed to continue in such office for one more year.
