The Dengue prevention campaign was initiated in the year 2016 by the Medical Sub-committee of the VOGA with the aim of eradicating and preventing the occurrence of mosquito breeding sites in the school premises.

A 'Shramadana Campaign' was executed under this initiative on the 7th of July 2019, with the help of the National Dengue Prevention Campaign and The Colombo Municipal

Council. A team of experts including Public Health Inspectors, Entomologists and Medical Officers of Health examined the school premises to identify the mosquito breeding sites and advised the relevant authorities to take necessary action. The Shramadana Campaign was carried out to eradicate the mosquito breeding sites, which was a timely measure to create a healthy and safe environment for our young Visakhians.

Annual Medical Camp

The Annual Medical Camp for the Teachers, organized by the WOGA, was held on 27th October at the school premises. Prof. Chandrika N. Wijeyaratne, Vice Chancellor at the University of Colombo graced the occasion as the Chief Guest while Prof. Anoja Fernando, former Dean of the Faculty of Medicine at University of Ruhuna was the Guest of Honour. The Medical Camp offered a comprehensive health package comprising over 20 specialties for past & present teachers and their families and members of the VVOGA. Development of the "Sick Room"

The Sickroom acts as the medical centre within Visakha Vidyalaya, providing medical care to students, teachers and other school staff in a timely manner. Therefore maintaining the standards of the sick room is of paramount importance. Sick room development project was initiated to meet the above need in year 2018 and was completed in the year 2019 by the Medical Sub-committee of the VVOGA. The team refurbished and upgraded the sickroom with new equipment, enabling the provision of better medical care for students and the school staff.

Visakhian, Senior Professor Chandrika N. Wijeyaratne

Was appointed as the new Vice Chancellor of University of Colombo on the 11th of April 2019. Prior to this appointment, she was the Senior Professor in Reproductive Medicine in the Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology at the University of Colombo, and the Honorary Consultant Physician & Endocrinologist at the De Soysa Hospital for Women. She was the 1st Endocrinologist to be appointed to an academic position in Sri Lanka and her work including extensive research and development in the field of Endocrinology with regard to public health in South Asia, led to receiving the 2017 Endocrine Society Laureate - International Excellence in Endocrinology Award. She also served as the 123rd President of the Sri Lanka Medical Association during 2017.



Visakhian Kalhari Bandara Goonewardana

Received the "Bio One Ambassador" award for 2018 for her research in poultry industry. This award recognizes early-career researchers who excel at communicating the importance and impact of their research beyond their discipline. Her research focused on raising healthy chicken by using alternative methods to Antibiotics, and thereby protecting the public health by preventing the growth of Antibiotic resistant bacteria in the environment. She was nominated for this award by the American Association of Avian Pathologists. A student of Visakha Vidyalaya from 1995 to 2004, Kalhari obtained Bachelor of Veterinary Science degree from the University of Peradeniya in 2018. She did internship training in Veterinary Clinical Medicine and Surgery and Poultry Disease Investigation and Diagnostic Pathology. She is currently attached to the Western College of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Saskatchewan, Canada and completing her PhD.

The UN Secretary General's Envoy on Youth was named as one of the rising stars in the TIME magazine's 'Time100 Next'. 




MESSAGES AND NOTICES
